

PORPLASTIC/INDOOR 10 point programme: cleaning – caring – maintaining

for synthetic surface systems in INDOOR sport facilities **PORPLASTIC INDOOR PEL / MEL / CEL**

In order to retain the required properties of PORPLASTIC synthetic surfaces as sports floors in the long term, these surfaces must be regularly maintained and only used for their intended purpose. The flooring is the most used part of a building.

Please refer to the guidelines of the manufacturer or ask your local maintenance company. To maintain reflexion, gloss and anti-skid properties only cleaners according to DIN V 18032-2 should be used.

In principle, the following rule applies: any damage to the floor should be immediately repaired by a specialist company to prevent any further damage. All repairs and any deep cleaning should only be carried out by qualified persons.

1. General

Measures to prevent the intake of dirt into the building should be taken. The cleaning intervals depend on the amount of dirt in a period of time. Only non-tainting shoes should be worn.

This cleaning instruction applies to all self-levelling, smooth **PORPLASTIC/INDOOR** synthetic resin surfaces based on polyurethane resin.

2. Sports Use

When participating in sport on **PORPLASTIC/INDOOR** synthetic surfaces, the proper footwear for the relevant sport should be worn. However, sport shoes with grip elements (such as spikes) must not be used in the indoor area.

Provisional colour markings may only be applied if they can be easily removed, do not damage the synthetic surface and comply with environmental requirements.

3. Care and Maintenance

In order to preserve the functionality of PORPLASTIC synthetic surfaces as sports floors, they must be regularly checked and cleaned.

3.1 basic cleaning

We suggest conducting a thorough cleaning about two times a year, to maintain the good appearance and a solid tidiness of the surface in the long term. Especially before first use, a basic cleaning should be performed. Only use cleaners suitable for INDOOR sports facilities.

3.2 maintenance cleaning (daily)

Depending on dirt collection, the upkeep cleaning, which is an especially fast, simple, practical and so cost-saving maintenance of the surface, can be conducted daily (depending on degree

of contamination). For conducting an upkeep cleaning, there are a lot of cleaners available. Wipe the surface moistly with a rollaway-bucket, a press or a ragtag.

3.3 Thorough cleaning: (periodically)

Use an alkaline cleaner and cleaning machines with non-scratching pads e. g. a one-plate-machine with yellow or red pad (depending on degree of contamination). Never use solvents for cleaning. After cleaning, the suds must be removed completely and the surface is to be rinsed with clear water. Afterwards, a new floor finish should be applied.

4. Repairs / service

Larger repairs should only be carried out by the manufacturer of the surface or a **PORPLASTIC Partner**.

Surfaces having a thin top layer, such as coatings or sealings, must be periodically reworked either overall or in specific areas, depending on the intensity of use and the resulting normal wear. If this type of restoration work is carried out at an early stage, the functionality of the sports surface will be retained over the long term. However, if reworking measures are postponed for too long, this will result in irreparable damage. Any such damage can only be remedied by the complete deinstallation of the floor, which will result in significantly higher restoration costs.

5. Harmful factors and immediate remedial action

Oil, fuels and various chemical liquids (cleaning agents in particular) cause ugly stains and, in larger quantities, permanent damage to the surface. We recommend to soak the contamination up as soon as possible with sand or sawdust and remove

Chewing gum can usually be peeled off after freezing with coolant spray

Burning cigarettes / cigars, fireworks and open flames cause melting spots and permanent damage to the surface, so it should be kept off the surface if possible and immediately extinguished.
